### **WYOMING FREE LIBRARY COMPUTER / INTERNET USE POLICY**

The mission of the Wyoming Free Library is to provide quality materials and services, which fulfill educational, informational, cultural and recreational needs for all the citizens of our community. Before using the Internet at the Wyoming Free Library, you should be aware of the following:

- Not all sources on the Internet provide information that is accurate, complete, current, legal or philosophically acceptable to all citizens.
- The Wyoming Free Library is unable to control or monitor the content of Internet sites, which change frequently.
- Patrons that have fines that of \$10.00 or more will be unable to access the computers.
- Patrons will be unable to access MySpace.
- Parents and guardians are the best and final judges of what is appropriate for their children and are responsible for their children's Internet use.
- All computer users must provide a Luzerne County Library System card to a library staff member at the circulation desk. Children under 18 must have a parent/legal guardian sign the agreement form. The patron will be assigned a terminal.
- Computer users can access the computer for as long as they need. If patrons are waiting for a computer, the current user can be asked to leave if they went over a 1-hour time limit. Users will be required to log off 30 minutes before closing time.
- Since our space is limited and increased noise from group conversation is disruptive to others, only two users may gather at a workstation.
- The Library expressly prohibits any use of library computers for illegal activities, or to access material that contains or makes reference to explicit sexual materials.
